Hello Assembly. Three motions were brought forward and Rockie Roper stepped forward to serve as Clark County Coordinator.

Motion1 That Denise Mraz be removed from any and all forms of assembly business temporarily until proper vetting can take place within our only assembly approved Vetting Committee which is at the State level.

The vetting process in question that allegedly took place at the county level was not agreed upon by the people. Clark County has no legitimate vetting process or committee. Therefore assembly members from Clark County claiming to be vetted by other assembly members in Clark County cannot do so in honor. An unvetted assembly member who has access to the peoples private records is a violation of their basic right to privacy.

Motion2 The previous Clark County Election for facilitator has no legitimacy. Proper notice should be given to the people to assemble for an election at a later date.

The people of Clark County were not given notice of the recent Election in question. Therefore the people of Clark County were denied their basic right to vote.

Motion3 All business is to be put on hold until the issues in motion 1 & 2 are corrected and accounted for and that the assembly conduct some direct deliberating in order to take measures that protect peoples rights from ever being violated again.

Clark County assembly members could attend the Nevada General Assembly Meeting until the current issues within the county have been resolved. Any forward progress without correcting these errors does so in violation of the peoples rights and jeopardizes all current progress.
