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Militia Priorities

- ▶ We are the Assembled People:

The Assembly Militia represents the collective desire and commitment of the people. We must share in this effort to ensure success. Sitting back and waiting for others to do the work for you will not achieve a desired outcome.

- ▶ The Well-being and Security of The People Must Be Our Highest Priority:

Confident, prosperous, resilient, and secure is the state we want to achieve. We will focus on this moving forward. Defending these ideals is our purpose.

- ▶ A Community of Like-Minded and Helpful People:

None of us can do this alone. Bring your talents and insight to the table for the benefit of all.

Role of the Nevada Assembly Militia

► Waging Peace

Our activities are peaceable. We recognize our status as free American State Nationals, and we engage those who wish us ill in a peaceful yet firm, lawful manner. We are neither fearful nor timid.

► Training & Education

In past times, the Militia typically focused on military readiness. Today, I propose that our initial focus should be instead on administrative competency and personal safety & security.

► Defense of the People

The Militia still has a role to play in thwarting invasion and insurrection; however, today this threat often comes from those who are ill-prepared to self-govern, or who have ulterior motives contrary to the interests of the people.

Militia as Protector

- ▶ It is Imperative That We Protect:

The Militia is the protector of the people, by the people. It is up to us to create a formidable defense and put it into action.

- ▶ Organization to this End is Essential:

We must be organized in this effort. Learning to research, share information and record everything is paramount. Maintain clear records of all interactions with the de facto authority.

- ▶ Even Small Efforts Can Help Immeasurably:

Even sharing personal stories of successes or defeats can provide invaluable insight to the rest of us. As we progress, we learn. As we learn, we generate success.

We Have a Situation...

- ▶ On or about October 1st of this year, I became aware of a recorded meeting that occurred on September 19, 2025, between two representatives of the Peacekeeping Task Force (PKTF), Executive Director Joe Hayse and Affiliate Director Louise Armstrong, and two American State Nationals, Denise Mraz and Rockie Roper.
- ▶ The PKTF was concerned about certain activities involving these two ASNs and sought to understand their perspectives.
- ▶ There were four points raised (see the transcript and recording), but the one issue that directly impacts the security of The Nevada Assembly is a concern that Rockie Roper was leading a parallel Nevada Assembly on his own.

PKTF Meeting

- ▶ Rockie admits during this meeting that he is “rebuilding” The Nevada Assembly because he feels that the actual Nevada Assembly has “pretty much stopped” working on building The Nevada Assembly.
- ▶ This, unfortunately, is an insult to all of the dedicated volunteers on The Nevada Assembly who are constantly working to improve and stand our sovereign National State.
- ▶ Rockie, along with those on Clark County who support him, believe that the situation is so dire that they must take control of the Nevada Assembly and “rebuild” it themselves.
- ▶ This is surprising since not one of their concerns has been formally raised with any of our established Nevada Assembly Committees.

Is Rockie Roper a Coordinator?

- ▶ Rockie Roper volunteered to be a County Coordinator on Clark County earlier this year, and the Clark County folks voted for him to be the Clark County Coordinator (facilitator) for them. He then needed to pass vetting with the Nevada Assembly Vetting Committee in order to assume that responsibility. He did not pass his vetting with TNA.
- ▶ Rockie never stood as a Nevada Assembly Co-coordinator and was never voted for by the entire Assembly membership.
- ▶ He has since claimed that Anna appointed him as a state coordinator, referencing an email you all now have where it appears she is under the impression he was already vetted.
- ▶ It is important to understand that the Federation never imposes a Coordinator on a state assembly without the state assembly vetting that person first.

Rockie Admits He Was Not Vetted

- ▶ During his PKTF meeting, Joe goes into great detail about what proper vetting for a State Coordinator really is. He says that the state must vet the candidate first, and then the Federation does its vetting.
- ▶ There is a recorded interview that includes 19 required questions to be asked and answered.
- ▶ Rockie admits he has never had such an interview.
- ▶ Joe is quite clear that without state approval and a successful vetting interview, the candidate has not completed vetting for a Federation position.
- ▶ During that meeting, Rockie admitted that Anna and Teri had never conducted such an interview with him.

Taking Control of The Nevada Assembly

- ▶ Since Rockie has been a self-proclaimed “coordinator”, he and those who support him have registered a new website and email address – thenevadaassemblygov.land
- ▶ The website has the Nevada Assembly seal displayed on it.



Taking Control of The Nevada Assembly (cont.)

- ▶ Rockie signs all of his official correspondence as “Rockie Roper, Nevada Coordinator, The Nevada Assembly as a whole”.
- ▶ His email is coordinator@thenevadassemblygov.land
- ▶ He states clearly in the PKTF meeting that they are creating state-level committees, like an Oversight Committee (to address Denise’s concerns, he says), and they have filled a state-level Militia Commander position with someone named “Shalon”.
- ▶ This is all happening without the knowledge or consent of The Nevada Assembly membership.
- ▶ This is happening through a vehicle termed the “Union of States”, or “Union State”, which can be confusing since it is an effort to stand states through a union of counties or a county assembly. This is encouraged by the PKTF.

What is to be Done?

- ▶ Well, all power lies with the people on our Assembly. No “authority” lies with any elected office or position. The best those in office or appointed positions can do is represent the interests of the Assembly members to the best of their ability. The final determination always goes back to the People.
- ▶ As your representative on the Militia, I view this as extremely destabilizing and a threat to the integrity and jurisdiction of the actual Nevada Assembly, and I have taken a few steps to defend it.
- ▶ What happens next will be up to all of us.
- ▶ The following details what has been done so far.

Bring Everything into the Open

- ▶ What is happening on Nevada now needs to be fully disclosed and discussed. It is not possible to ignore this and hope it all gets better on its own.
- ▶ Each man and woman has a say in the future of our Assembly, and if you care about self-governance, now is the time to show it.
- ▶ I filed a “Notice of Claims and Testimonial” this morning, as a living man on Nevada, to notice Rockie to cease these divisive tactics in the interest of the future of our Assembly. This was NOT done in my capacity as Militia Commander, rather as an ASN/C on Nevada.
- ▶ We will undoubtedly need to face the likelihood that he will complain to others outside the state about this, but this is a Nevada issue, and he should resolve this with Nevadans.

Stick to the Facts and Formalize

- ▶ No one should ever criticize, accuse, or disparage another ASN or The Nevada Assembly without factual evidence to support their assertions and formalize their grievances through the established mechanisms available to them.
- ▶ Baseless talk, rumors and gossip are what have caused this to get so far out of hand to begin with. If a member of The Nevada Assembly has a grievance, make it known, in writing, with demonstrable evidence to our Oversight Committee. We conduct all our work through committees, ensuring everyone has an equal opportunity to be heard and maintaining transparency in all our activities.
- ▶ Each of us has an equal voice and vote, and when a consensus is reached based on verifiable facts, we adhere to the result.

The PKTF

- ▶ It appears that the PKTF has engaged with Rockie & Denise in furtherance of their indispensable work to “establish a lawful Soil Jurisdiction nation state Assembly within their county boundaries”.
- ▶ I have added a document recently posted on the PKTF blog, entitled “Establishing Lawful County Assemblies and the Role of the Soil Jurisdiction Sheriff Under the Federation Framework,” which may have many questioning the PKTF’s ability to speak in plain English. They say that they should “be welcomed and afforded unfettered access to engage with all levels of de jure peacekeeping across the States”.
- ▶ Should they be sincere in their desire to help stand the states, it is reasonable for them to meet with the state assembly leadership within the state with which they are engaged.
- ▶ They are in contact with Rockie and have designated Clark County a “Model County,” but they have yet to meet with anyone at the Nevada Assembly level. I sent a letter to our Nevada PKTF liaison, Jennifer Olsen, (included) inquiring about this, and we are still waiting for a direct answer as to when they would like to meet with us.

Conclusion

- ▶ As Self-Governing People, We Must Behave Accordingly. It is time for us to address the issues that divide us and create space for everyone to participate together in this monumental effort to overcome the shackles we have all grown up with.
- ▶ We must also confront uncomfortable challenges to our right to self-governance, even if those challenges arise not from criminal de facto government contractors, but from our own burgeoning efforts to govern ourselves.
- ▶ Clearing the air and providing all Assembly members with factual information is key to progressing from where we are today to where we need to be tomorrow.
- ▶ Having faith in our fellow men and women, as well as the systems in place to address disagreements with verifiable truth, will set us on the path to success.

Now for Some Fun! Nevada Assembly FLAG

I have been thinking about the need for ways to strengthen our pride and our legitimacy as a nation-state, and I am proposing we consider adding a State Flag to our Assembly. We will be taking this issue up with the GPP Committee very soon. We will be following the vexillography standards (yes, that's a real thing) for a state flag. This proposed design for Nevada should be a simple, meaningful, and distinctive flag that reflects the state's unique identity, history, and culture. Please submit any ideas or thoughts you may have to Jennifer Olsen, the GPP Chair, or through Sue Hulsebus, State Coordinator.

Seals & Documents

- ▶ I am also asking the GPP Committee to start reviewing ideas for official pillar seals for the Militia, Jural, and International Business pillars. We should have seals available for these pillars, which can be put to use in official Communication and Activities.
- ▶ Along with that are official document standards, which denote everything from font style and size to seal position and other details for our official communication.

Nevada Assembly SWAG!

- ▶ Lastly and most entertainingly, ASN Keith Hall suggested official Nevada Assembly Swag should be developed. T-shirts, Polos, Sweats, Coffee mugs, Pens, etc., can be sold to promote the Assembly, prompt questions about who we are, and aid in outreach.
