You know, an event was planned by the militia commander. He was going to have a public event that involved outreach at his home, at his farm, and the public was invited. But the outreach committee was not involved, and the General Assembly never voted on any of this, and there was no

official agenda or program for this event Submitted to the General Assembly and yet the General Assembly was the quote-unquote sponsoring Organization and they were expected to pay for the advertising and things like that and know the militia is a is a part

And the militia needs to work with the General Assembly because the General Assembly is ultimately responsible for the actions of the militia, not the other way around. And what you wind up with are situations where scaldogorous scheming federal agencies are

sometimes clocked doing very nefarious things to try to mislead, implicate, or accuse our assemblies and our members of doing things that they aren't doing or wouldn't do except that they're being misled. And we've had some very notable examples where, especially the FBI,

will hire or coerce someone to act as a snitch and infiltrate our organization and do things that are an attempt to mislead our assemblies into taking actions that can be interpreted as illegal or insurrectionist activities against the government. And I will just very briefly

describe two or three of the sorts of things that we've had to deal with in the past. There was a young man named Shaver Cox here in Alaska, very young man, but an eloquent and patriotic speaker who knew his constitution well and who still had the naive assumption that the government was our government and not a government subcontractor.

The FBI got hold of the man who had a federal criminal history already and caught him doing something else and threatened him into being a snitch and infiltrating the group around Schaefer and getting Schaefer to talk about a contingency plan in the event that some other thing happened.

Now there was no evidence whatsoever of anyone moving a finger toward actually implementing anything or doing anything related to this plan. But nonetheless, because this quote unquote contingency plan based on an event that hadn't happened and probably wouldn't happen, involved kidnapping a federal judge.

And just because they got Schaefer to talk about this in a theoretical context, they threw the book in him and he's serving a 26-year sentence effectively for a thought crime, which of course is not anything under American law.

all these beliefs about the law and about America and about justice and an FBI snitch from Texas named Michael Hamilton, who admitted to being a federal insurance agent, came up to Colorado and got everybody all hooked up and angry and
