Indeed, Anna. Louise is correct in her findings and mine. Please do find time to review what is being taught by this Militia Commander from The Nevada Assembly, State of the Union. Link: fcdl.in/WO8IUvsgef for your convenience. Louise has also provided a very convenient follow-along transcript with timestamps for your added convenience. It is never our goal to directly or indirectly squander or preoccupy your precious time, Anna. And so, if Louise or I reach out to your office for your direct or indirect collaborative assistance, please know it will be of the utmost importance where Public Safety, International Outreach, Charter Maintenance, Universal Emergency Service Recognition, Support, and Protection, and matters of lawful funding are concerned.

Thanks to The Nevada Assembly having a PKTF - Assembly Liaison in place and others from this particular assembly, we were able to identify this language as coming solely from the current Militia Commander/Director/Steward. This was a fairly disturbing Militia Pillar committee meeting replay - at least in terms of continuous railing against progress or the possibility of progress in terms of State Border Defense, Community Resilience (becoming familiar with that local concept), and the very reality of simultaneous Union State Assembly development.

This is the same Commander that has consistently pushed back against Federation facilitation of anything having to do with his State of the Union beyond that of maintaining a single Coordinator. Likewise, despite our ongoing efforts, according to my recollection and current email receipts, I have received no positive feedback from this Commander's office regarding cooperation on any such Federation-facilitated projects, outreach, or assembly development. Nevertheless, this Commander mentioned herein from The Nevada Assembly, State of the Union, IS a community member on our PeaceBridgeNetwork, but it is not known if his office has attempted to converse with anyone else from that ecosystem on those matters brought up during this recent committee replay, nor is known to share any ongoing concerns or ideas; his office (from that networking space) does not reach out to the general public of peacekeepers and peace-builders, and has not yet provided a trusted Point of Contact beyond their current PKTF - Assembly Liaison. Be that as it may, nevertheless, The Nevada Assembly, Union State IS working very well with the other participating states to work through the same or similar issues and is working to have suitable course-correction methods countering such climatization issues as part of their guidebook reference, building off those experiences and others as they work to put together a stellar Union State Assembly Guidebook.

In the meantime - between your office and mine - perhaps we can put together a dedicated set of articles that can help motivate all State of the Union, Militia Assembly committee decision-makers to stay focused on the clear and present state of emergency danger all states are in and work diligently with all known peaceful resources that are pulling together to make state-border protection success a reality.

Here are the highlights.

What I want to bring your attention is the Militia Commander's education and position taken before The Nevada Assembly in this meeting. Summarily, these 3 positions that he takes:

1. The Federation including the PKTF and Continental Marshals are foreign to the Nevada Assembly. They are not the government, we are. We can accept their advocacy or leave it.
2. Anyone promoting a "Union State" is spreading propaganda. There is no legal basis in law, history or the

Constitutions for it. Instead, all my research proves that the Counties have no power other than what the State gives them.

3. The Nevada Assembly will entertain a motion to retire the term "Union State" from the Assembly's usage.

Fiduciary, you can observe from the Militia Commander's language that he has taken the position that the Federation and the PKTF is attacking The Nevada Assembly by promoting the Union State:

- "a threat to jurisdiction"
- "a threat to the integrity of the state"
- "let's cut this poison out as quick as we can"
- "It's creating conflict"
- "against us"

And I will observe to you further, Fiduciary, it is I, the Affiliate Director, again being targeted as the cause for their "conflict." However, on the contrary, it appears to me that their need to learn what a Union State really is appears to be the cause of the conflict on his Assembly from what I'm hearing. No one brought forth any real education on the matter as he spoke.

And I didn't have any preconceptions. Well, like I said, I was confused about this idea of the union states and calling counties union states. I didn't understand where that came from.

I couldn't figure out what the heck it was supposed to be. Why change it from what every state recognizes as a county to a union state? I think I've got an answer and we're going to talk about that.

There were nine counties there to begin with. And then how that developed over time. And then, of course, we're going to look at what the Federation guidance has been on this, because we tap into that resource in order to clarify our thinking on on certain things.

It's not a compact. It's not a contract between the state and the county. The state says how the counties are going to go.

That's how it is. The counties don't have any jurisdiction to declare anything otherwise. It comes from the legislature.

So, in the first paragraph of this opinion, it says, counties, cities, and towns are municipal corporations created by the authority of the legislature and they derive all their powers from the source of their creation. So, the counties spring from the state. It's not the other way around.

They have no inherent jurisdiction to make laws or adopt governmental regulations, nor can they exercise any other powers in that regard than such as are expressly implied or expressly or implicitly derived from their exercise or from their charters. So, the statutes of the state or the direction of the legislature is what provides them with their existence. All right.

The other one is Hunter v. Pittsburgh. This is in 1907.

So, they created Clark County. The legislature created Clark County in 1909. Counties are tools of the state created to serve the people, not sovereign bodies capable of outranking the state.

We're going to go into this a little bit more here in a minute. Now, here's another thing that's always kind of bugged me a little bit. They talk about this six inch, six inches of soil on the top of the county.

That's the county's jurisdiction. Well, when you really examine, it's pretty silly to begin with. And as it turns out, there's no legal basis for that at all.

The whole is the union. It's interesting. I didn't know this before I got into this research, but the word county doesn't appear anywhere in the Constitution at all.

Not once. So there's not a single amendment, nor do they declare cities, townships, municipalities. None of that is in the Constitution.

None of it. The federal charter is silent on all local subdivisions, and that is key. All of the above-mentioned political subdivisions are subdivisions of a state.

They're creatures of state law, and you can go validate this on your own. Madison settled it in the Federalist No. 39.

The people act. They act as states. A county is nowhere in the chain, ever.

So what a county actually is, there have been some court cases on this. There's one called Laramie County versus Albany County. Let me get my notes here so I don't wreck this.

So here is a little kind of a breakdown to look at how this term Union State came to us. It came down. This is not something that, the genesis is not within our assembly.

It never came from us. The concept originated someplace, I don't know where, in the Federation. The PKF picked it up and their affiliate director really got going with it.

That's Louise Campbell-Anthony. She's the one who started the model county programs that caused us a lot of turmoil and strife here on Nevada. She's rebranded it and I don't have the name right in front of me, something else.

But it's all county first kind of, and I'll just say it flatly, it's propaganda. It doesn't have any substance behind it. And then our friends down south picked it up and it's what they're using to justify their activities right now.

But if you look at the graphic here, this had nothing to do with us. It's all outside the assembly. So we can accept what these outside folks say or we can reject it.

These outside folks are foreign entities. The Federation is a foreign entity. That doesn't mean they're our enemy.

And we have every right to ask questions and to determine whether or not this is a good fit for us. That's what self-governance is all about. So the Federation is an advocacy organization.

It stands outside of the assembly. It's not a government. It's not our parent.

It doesn't run our state. It doesn't presume to. As far as I can tell, officially, it doesn't presume to run any assembly anywhere in the union.

There's nothing elected about the Federation at all. And they're grateful for the stuff that they put out that's been helpful. That's great.

But they don't have any accountability to anyone. They can just do what they feel is best. That's fine.

Go ahead. The appointments that they make to the assembly, which are their coordinator program, are supposed to be here to assist. And those assembly appointments are all provisional.

The minute the state seats itself, there's no further need for provisional appointments from the Federation here on Nevada. So it all sunsets. It goes away.

The bottom line is we accept what we decide to accept. Advocacy is offered. It is not imposed.

The assembly weighs what the Federation brings and decides for itself whether and how to apply it. The same goes for the PKTF. The same goes for even the Continental Marshals to a degree.

They are an external organization. They are supposed to be concerned with interstate foreign crime, criminal activity, trafficking, and things like that, certain kinds of commerce. They don't get involved in our internal architecture here in the state.

We do that. So who benefits in this whole deal? We've already identified that every test that we can apply to this idea, the idea fails.

It doesn't exist. And I've got a bonus slide here in just a minute that I'm going to talk about that even sinks the whole idea even deeper. So we have four independent sources right now that we've looked at.

And you can pick and choose between them, but that's four. And there's one verdict in all of them. It's not present.

But this union state concept, this idea that the soil jurisdiction has some superiority over the state is just complete nonsense. It's unfounded propaganda originating outside of our assembly. And it's the load-bearing concept for everything that's aimed against us.

That's the part that goes with the union. The union is the collective states working together. The counties are subdivisions of the state.

The counties, they serve as functionary organs of the state. A county is not a union state. There's no place it can get there.

I don't think Clark County is talking about seceding from Nevada. But that's the only way they achieve any kind of state authority of any sort. They would have to secede and be the 51st state.

Otherwise, they need to work within the confines of their jurisdiction and work within the confines of the state jurisdiction. It is just black letter law. And it goes all the way back to constitutional and American common law, all the way back.

There is no variance throughout the American experience that indicates that a county can have anything other than what the state gives it. That's it. So, hopefully, that addresses a couple of things.

On August 5th, I personally will make a motion that the Nevada Assembly abolish the doctrine that any county is or may be a union state or holds jurisdiction independent of or superior to the state. And that the term union state be retired from all assembly usage. And I'm bringing this up here because this is a serious motion.

I want everybody thinking about it. And then I want to have a deeper discussion about it on August 5th. We use the Constitution's own words.

We put that up because we wanted the counties to get together and work out, you know, issues that affected all the counties. And we thought, okay, the federation says we should be calling these union states. So we created a charter.

I'm the facilitator in Carson City. So I was one of the people that chartered the document to set up the Nevada Union State Assembly. Keith came to me and he goes, we got to change the name.

Because I gave him some of this information. We were talking about the counties and how works. He goes, no, we got to change the name.

So I'm going to make a motion that we remove this fictitious term from our vocabulary because there's no There's no reference point other than from a small group of people who are promoting it and it's creating a lot of turmoil and damage. So it's a from the perspective of a militia commander. This is a threat to jurisdiction.

This is a threat to the integrity of the state. This is something that's going on here that has no fundamental basis in law history or, you know, the Constitution delegated authority to the federal government, the union. But the states retain their Undelegated authority and their undelegated authority is setting up counties and municipalities and doing things that benefit the state, how it's always worked, how it works everywhere.

So that's my argument for the assembly is that let's cut this poison out as quick as we can, because it's not helping us. It's creating conflict where it shouldn't even even exist. There's no There's no reference for it anywhere that I can find and please Do your own research, man.
