I don't think you have every given me a chance as an ASN member or have ever asked to speak to me.

I am a coordinator and my position is to help people in Nevada State, no matter what county they're in. I've been in training since 2022 with Craig Schmidt, we did training in LRO, coordinator, banking, passport, mocee process and more.

You have mentioned "They aren't part of the only Federation recognized Assembly", I am not understanding what you're trying to say with that. There is only one Nevada State Assembly! And Sue is the organizer who does the general meetings for the State.

We are all aware that every state has ONE federation recognized State Assembly. Could you please let me know who is "Nevada State Assembly"?

You also said, "they don't study and the only thing care about is the money"

I don't know where you get your information from because I have not seen you participate in any of our meetings, if you would have been a part of our meetings, you would know that we put a lot of time in training! I am always in Anna's Mondays and Thursday meetings, I ask many questions and talk about the progress we have made in the Union State and Counties of Nevada.

And also, I am wanting to know who do you mean by "they"?

Let's talk about Tamara for example. She is in Nye County, NOT Clark County. She has been wanting to step up now for over 1 yr. She has also send you an email to get her background done for recording secretary position and on August 11th 2025, you've responded : Work with your Assembly.

I have been trying to help her with the recording secretary and coordinator position but I keep being denied with any information.

Tamara has been in training with Aaron, our head recording secretary, for over a year. She also was involved with helping "Stand Up" in creating the forms for their software.

Tamara has been attending Sue's Wednesday's meetings for a very long time. She is working with Sue to get trained for State

Coordinator position and is now attending Lisa's State Coordinator classes.

This is an example of the people in Southern Nevada who want training and are seeking training, not everything about all the members are published everywhere and if you would have been working with us, you would have known how involved our ASN's are in Nevada. And the training does not come from The Nevada Assembly.

Fitu is a Clark County ASN and has been helping for several years. She is part of our Oversight Committee, she also has been training for recording secretary with Aaron for over a year. She's also very involved with the Resources Committee and helps many people in Hawaii also.

So, my question again to you Teri, how do the 3 of us proceed in being a part of the LRO? (you have done my background check)

We have contacted Sue on many occasions about the positions needed in building the State level Assembly and until this date we have never gotten an answer from her. So, how do you say we're not trying to be involved with the State Assembly process?

Currently in the Union State Assembly, all positions in one of the counties have been completely filled and all committees are going through the jural assembly handbook and building their procedures.

Money: As a coordinator in Nevada, I get several questions about GFG/ bank almost every day and I try to answer them to the best knowledge and training in this subject. The reason I get these questions, I have many ASN's who are losing their jobs, homes, health, families and want to know if there is any relief coming from GFG soon. So, it's not all about the money but right now it would help a lot with the people in our state and I'm assuming also in all other states.

As you can see, all of us are willing to help the State and the Counties Assemblies, at this point Teri, you need to give us instructions on how to be a recording secretary. And please answer all the above questions I have asked.

I appreciate your help and I'm looking forward to keep building our State and Counties.

By definition all County Assembly members are recognized as members of their State Assembly, because land and soil are **in perpetual union**, as we have often discussed --- whether they **actively participate** at both levels and become active members of both the State and County Assemblies or not, is another question.

The conundrum is that the LRO office is a State Assembly Office and if individuals choose not to participate at that level, it would not be appropriate for them to have access to the State LRO. On the other hand, if individuals join both the State and the County Assemblies open to them, it would be appropriate for them to serve as State Recording Secretaries as part of their work at the State level, and such service would be under the auspices of The Nevada Assembly.
