Seals and logos have their own symbolic language --- and I assume you are asking so that you do this correctly and maybe learn about that some more?

Well, they are all beautiful and someone obviously has graphic skills that we are thankful for!

That said, the County represents the most fundamental and in a way, the most powerful, building block in the American Government. It operates on the pure raw power of the people without regard for any delegations of power, because apart from its delegation of international powers to the State, the County retains all other powers without any other delegation at all --- which makes the County the "seat of power" ---- hence the saying, "county seat".

Now, with that background, realize that a circle indicates limitation or delegation of power. That's why the Federal Government's use of the Great Seal shows it inside a circle.

So, you don't want to use a circle on a county seal, because the county is essentially "unbound" -- it's powers are not circumscribed, not delegated.

All three of these designs use circles or "circles implied" in the third case, so what I would recommend is using a "broken circle" --- instead of a solid circle, use a circle of stars or a circle made of some other design element that breaks the continuous outline of the circle and "allows the power to move freely" in and out of the boundary of the circle.

The other point is the use of the color blue, which is emblematic of the sea. Land and soil jurisdiction colors include greens, browns, golds, and reds. So I would not choose blue.
