The unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America, When in the Course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

Re: Cease and Desist – Trademark Infringement, Cybersquatting, and Unfair Competition Involving Domain Name thenevadaassemblygov.land

Dear Registrant:

The Nevada Assembly (the "Assembly"), a private non-profit organization operating at its official website nevadaassembly.org, demands that you immediately cease and desist from all use of the domain name thenevadaassemblygov.land (the "Infringing Domain") and transfer the Infringing Domain to The Nevada Assembly.

The Assembly has been continuously using the name "The Nevada Assembly" and the domain nevadaassembly.org since at least 2022 in connection with its services as a membership organization focused on education regarding political status correction, restoration of self-governance under common law, and related activities for its approximately 300 members. Through this longstanding and exclusive use, the Assembly has established valuable common law trademark rights in "The Nevada Assembly" as a distinctive identifier of its organization and services.

You have registered and are using the Infringing Domain thenevadaassemblygov.land, which is confusingly similar to the Assembly's mark and official domain. The addition of "the," "gov," and the ".land" extension does not diminish the confusion; in fact, the inclusion of "gov" falsely suggests an official governmental affiliation or endorsement, which is particularly deceptive given the Assembly's focus on land and soil jurisdiction matters. Your website at the Infringing Domain claims to represent "The Nevada Union State" as an "unincorporated government serving the national land and soil jurisdiction of Nevada," directly competing with and misrepresenting the Assembly's legitimate work. Furthermore, your use of the Infringing Domain

to communicate with the Assembly's members constitutes intentional targeting and an attempt to divert members, confuse the public, and undermine the Assembly's jurisdiction and operations.

Your actions constitute:

- **Trademark Infringement** and **Unfair Competition** under the Lanham Act (15 U.S.C. §§ 1114, 1125(a));
- **Cybersquatting** under the Anticybersquatting Consumer Protection Act (ACPA, 15 U.S.C. § 1125(d)), as the Infringing Domain was registered and used in bad faith with intent to profit from or disrupt the Assembly's goodwill;
- Potential violations of other state and federal laws prohibiting deceptive trade practices and false representation.

These actions are causing ongoing harm to the Assembly's reputation, member trust, and operations.

Demands:

1. Immediately cease all use of the Infringing Domain, including disabling the associated website and ceasing any email or other communications using addresses tied to it.
2. Transfer full ownership and control of the Infringing Domain to the Nevada Assembly within **ten (10) days** of receipt of this letter. You may initiate the transfer through your registrar.
3. Provide written confirmation that you have complied with the above and will not register or use any domain names incorporating "Nevada Assembly" or confusingly similar terms in the future.
4. Cease all representations that your activities are affiliated with, endorsed by, or representative of The Nevada Assembly.

Failure to comply fully within **ten (10) days** will leave the Assembly no choice but to pursue all available remedies, including:

- Filing a Uniform Domain-Name Dispute-Resolution Policy (UDRP) complaint with an ICANN-approved provider (e.g., WIPO or Forum) seeking transfer of the domain;
- Initiating federal court action under the ACPA, seeking transfer, cancellation, statutory damages up to \$100,000 per domain, actual damages, and attorneys' fees;
- Other lawful claims as appropriate.

This letter is without prejudice to the Assembly's rights and remedies, all of which are expressly reserved.

Govern yourself accordingly.

Explanation:

General Elections and Quorum Committee:

Handles notices and candidate publications, sets dates, promotes participation in elections, provides ballots, poll watchers, and ballot security.

Vetting Committee:

The vetting committee approves membership and reviews candidate eligibility for elected positions, including background checks and "interviews" applicable to the positions being applied for. The committee requires at least 3 members to function properly, but it is best to have more. The chair is elected by the General Assembly and member are unelected volunteers. County level vetting committee members and chair can be vetted and trained by either the Federation or state level vetting committee

state level vetting committee.

General Education Committee:

Produces educational materials and programs for the General Assembly Members. Chair is elected by the General Assembly, vetted by the State or County vetting committee.

Vetted Roles:

- * chairman pro tem
- * recording secretary
- * treasurer- county
- * ombudsman
- * marshal at arms

Explanation:

Chairman pro tem:

Spokesperson of the assembly, and is responsible for the overall conduct of business including meetings of the general assembly.
pro tem-- in training

Recording Secretary:

Responsible to examine what they're recording and to make sure all paperwork is correct. Everyone needs to be properly declared, recorded, and published as either a State National or State Citizen.

Treasurer:

The Treasurer handles the financial needs of the Assembly, collecting and depositing any funds received, distributing outgoing payments and maintaining an accurate and up to date ledger. He/she is the primary signatory on the Assembly's bank account.

This is an American State Citizen position elected by the General Assembly.

Treasurers are vetted by a Federation level vetting team that includes at least one Continental Marshal.

Requirements for Treasurer

- Knowledge of how to keep a ledger, whether on paper or via bookkeeping software
- Knowledge of carriage accounting (simple ledgering) contrary to double accrual accounting used by corporations.

Ombudsman Committee:

Provides conflict resolution and arbitration services, general resolution services. A highly functioning Ombudsman committee prevents the courts from being overloaded because they help bring resolution to perceived harm before it becomes a court issue.

Marshal at Arms:

The Marshal at Arms ensures the safety and decorum at all meetings and

events, providing safety and security of the meeting place itself and the people at the meeting. He/she cares for the flag and works with the Elections Committee to secure ballots. The Marshal at Arms serves all 4 pillars of the Assembly—all meetings, all people. He/she can appoint and train others to assist with various duties, but the responsibility remains with the Marshal. The county Marshal at Arms is elected by the county General Assembly. This position is vetted by a Federation level vetting team that includes at least one Continental Marshal.

Requirements for Marshal at Arms

- Knowledge of public safety procedures
- Firearm competency
- Communication skills that include the ability to diffuse heated situations
- The means to travel easily to areas requiring protection

Organizational Supports:

- * county coordinator
- * secretary record keeping
- * IT/ Infrastructure
- * outreach/ events
- * oversight

Explanation:

County Coordinator:

The Coordinator is acting as an organizer for the Assembly. The Coordinator is not a Public Officer but is rather an expediter, someone knowledgeable to act a rallying point for the group and its activities.

The Coordinator has some considerable amount of responsibility for assisting people in making the transition, getting their paperwork in order and helping guide the Assembly to move forward.

The Coordinator must be honest and inclusive and stand above politics and paranoia.

Responsibilities of a Coordinator

- Overseeing and managing the formation of the four pillars
- Responding to new inquiries, answering questions and pointing people to educational materials
- Keeping a well organized database of all nationals as well as new people who request information
- Vetting/sorting newly landed men and women to help identify if this is the right Assembly for them and if so, where their skills and talents might best be used
- Organizing your General Assembly meetings
- Distributing information to the people on your county
- Maintaining records of all meeting agendas, minutes and recordings

Plans and executes events, live meetings, and election set-up

Oversight Committee:

Provides general oversight and a forum for complaints: Works with each of the other committees to ensure that they are operating with integrity and with honor. Reviews complaints pertaining to the operation of a committee and presents to the General Assembly

Jury Pool Committee:

Develops pools of competent and eligible Jurors to serve on both Trial Juries and Grand Juries, administers selection of Jurors, reimbursement of expenses, and other issues related to maintaining and caring for Jurors.

Sheriff's Committee:

Works with the County Sheriffs to evaluate and bring forward the concerns of the Assembly County Sheriffs to better assist them in the performance of their duties.

Sheriffs

Our Sheriffs are public peacekeeping officials. Sheriffs only exist at the County level, and are the highest ranking law official in the County, even above defacto LEOs ("Law Enforcement Officers") and district officials. County Sheriffs are the embodiment of the Public Law and the executors of the Law of the Land and the Law of the Soil within their County's borders.

Eligibility:

- American State Citizen position, required to have 928 doc package.
- no dual citizenships.
- no licenses that create divided allegiances.

The County Sheriff is elected by County Jural Assembly Members who are automatically State Jural Assembly Members and vice versa.

Justice of the Peace:

The Justice of the Peace insures the court is running like it is supposed to, they keep the peace in the courts. Justice of the Peace ultimately signs the order from the jury.

Court Clerk:

Clerks set the venue of court cases, they determine where a case belongs, in which court and jurisdiction, and they assign it to a Judge, Justice, or a Justice of the Peace to "shepherd" the proceedings. First they identify the kind of action being pursued and the nature of the people or persons pursuing it, and correctly direct it to the appropriate jurisdiction and appropriate court within that jurisdiction.

jural support:

Explanation:

Jural Assembly Secretary:

Like the General Assembly Secretary, The Jural Assembly Secretary is responsible for taking minutes in a court hearing.

Record Keeper:

We are making history and it is very important that everything be documented and saved. Record Keepers need to be very trustworthy because they will have direct access to all members personal information.

Court Recorder:

The recorder creates and preserves the Public and Private Records upon which the legitimacy and proof of the proper functioning of the Jural Assembly depend. Securing the Records in multiple copies and in multiple locations is also necessary.

Bondsman:

Bondsman are court level roles, they take charge of prisoners and ensure their safety and good conduct while in court. The role can also extend beyond the boundaries of the Court as Bondsman, they may assist Sheriffs and other Public Law Officials in performance of their duties. Bondsman maintain the security of the actual courtroom and direct traffic within it. They may also seat people in the court gallery, help those who are physically injured or disabled, distribute educational information to

members of the Jural Assembly, instruct people on how to post bonds—rees guaranteeing future future performance of actions—that are retained and accounted for by the Court Clerk's Office, and act in similar capacities. The Bondsman in a court is meant to be a reassuring figure for those participating in or witnessing the proceedings, as well as a stalwart protector of everyone concerned, including those accused of crimes.

Coroner:

The office of County Coroner is in fact one of the Primary Offices of the American Government, the Coroner is the only Public Official who can remove a sitting Governor from office, of all the Public Offices, the Office of the Coroner is "the office of greatest trust". In order to fully function, the actual land and soil jurisdiction government requires a Coroner, who must be a competently trained medical professional. The County Coroner only serves cases involving members of the State Jural Assembly (State Citizens) and those who have recorded their State National political status with the State Jural Assembly Recorder. County Coroners also have an important role of recording births. The actual County Coroner's office certifies both births and deaths and has them recorded by the State Jural Assembly Recorder's Office prior to serving Notice to the Territorial Government by providing a copy of the public record.

Eligibility:

- Retired Medical Doctors and Nurses who no longer use their licenses
- Men and Women trained as Physician's Assistants in the course of their military training who for whatever reasons did not choose to make use of that training in private life.
- Someone who has reasonable training and experience to be able to certify that a man is dead and to give an educated opinion of the cause of death.

The Militia is equivalent to a Community National Guard, always prepared and ready for service. State Militias are manned by State Citizens who are members of the State Jural Assembly, Their focus is community safety and preparedness on a statewide basis. Members are taught firearms safety, marksmanship, first aid, and train in one or more specialties.

Militia Eligibility

All able bodied members of the Assembly over the age of 21 are expected to actively support their militia in one way or another, either as active militia or acting in support, (supply, communications, or

administrative positions.) There is always something to help out with, no matter how small a task, it all can help in a big way.

Militia Commander:

The role of the Militia Commander is to help us get better organized and prepared to take similar actions in the future, to train us to our lawful standing, so that we know the Law that applies to us and to our public employees, and also, to build the relationships that allow us to work cooperatively with any other peacekeeping or law enforcement or agency personnel that may be on the ground or in the air. Needs to know practical skills and to train those skills. Regulate and staff, inspire, educate, and develop the skills of our militia members as individuals and as a group.

As you know, Coordinators step forward as ASN volunteers, are trained, and take up their task of helping their State get organized. But there are actually two States that are being organized -- to one degree or another -- at the same time: the State of the Union, which is what we are concentrating on right now, and the Union State arising from the Counties, which is becoming another focus as counties get organized. It is my understanding that Rocky stepped forward to assist as a Co-Coordinator, has been vetted, and so, accepted as a Coordinator

in Nevada.

That doesn't mean he is the "only" Coordinator in Nevada.

There may have been a confusion as to which "State" he is helping to organize --- the State of the Union or the Union State (at the County level).

I suggested that Nevadans resolve any such confusion by continuing to call the State of the Union Assembly: The Nevada Assembly, and calling the Union State Assembly: The Nevada Union State Assembly.

Please talk to him and iron things out so that everyone knows what is going on. Everyone in Nevada is eligible to participate as part of the population of the Union State at the county level, or the State of the Union level, or both.

As a Coordinator or Treasurer or Banking Committee Member of the Nevada State of the Union, Rocky can serve as the GFG Bank Contact, but, please note that banking is an international activity, so it falls under the purview of the State of the Union, not the Union State.

All GFG wants is a steady, agreed upon contact person that they can entrust with a secured email and phone access to GFG Help Desks.

The idea is that instead of trying to field fifty million calls from individual account holders, there will be one contact person on each assembly whose job will be to act as the go-to person for people to ask for answers to bank questions. The Bank Contact can then use the secure lines to get answers.

Okay? That's the purpose of asking each State Assembly for a Contact Person.

I personally think that it would be suicide for any Coordinator to act as the Bank Contact, but that's me. I am advising each Assembly to look for someone who has a good phone and internet service connection, hopefully someone with the patience of Job, and a sterling character, to serve as Bank Contact. At least initially there will be a ton of questions.

Again, it may not have been clear that it's the State of the Union that is being tasked with this, not the Union State.

Please reconnoiter among yourselves and sort out your differences and understand the different roles and jurisdictions involved.

Dear Registrant:

The Nevada Assembly (the "Assembly"), a private non-profit organization operating at its official website nevadaassembly.org, demands that you immediately cease and desist from all use of the domain name thenevadaassemblygov.land (the "Infringing Domain") and transfer the Infringing Domain to The Nevada Assembly.

The Assembly has been continuously using the name "The Nevada Assembly" and the domain nevadaassembly.org since at least 2022 in connection with its services as a membership organization focused on education regarding political status correction, restoration of self-governance under common law, and related activities for its approximately 300 members. Through this longstanding and exclusive use, the Assembly has established valuable common law trademark rights in "The Nevada Assembly" as a distinctive identifier of its organization and services.

You have registered and are using the Infringing Domain thenevadaassemblygov.land, which is confusingly similar to the Assembly's mark and official domain. The addition of "the," "gov," and the ".land" extension does not diminish the confusion; in fact, the inclusion of "gov" falsely suggests an official governmental affiliation or endorsement, which is particularly deceptive given the Assembly's focus on land and soil jurisdiction matters. Your website at the Infringing Domain claims to represent "The Nevada Union State" as an "unincorporated government serving the national land and soil jurisdiction of Nevada," directly competing with and misrepresenting the Assembly's legitimate work. Furthermore, your use of the Infringing Domain

to communicate with the Assembly's members constitutes intentional targeting and an attempt to divert members, confuse the public, and undermine the Assembly's jurisdiction and operations.

Your actions constitute:

- **Trademark Infringement and Unfair Competition** under the Lanham Act (15 U.S.C. §§ 1114, 1125(a));
- **Cybersquatting** under the Anticybersquatting Consumer Protection Act (ACPA, 15 U.S.C. § 1125(d)), as the Infringing Domain was registered and used in bad faith with intent to profit from or disrupt the Assembly's goodwill;
- Potential violations of other state and federal laws prohibiting deceptive trade practices and false representation.

These actions are causing ongoing harm to the Assembly's reputation, member trust, and operations.

Demands:

1. Immediately cease all use of the Infringing Domain, including disabling the associated website and ceasing any email or other communications using addresses tied to it.
2. Transfer full ownership and control of the Infringing Domain to the Nevada Assembly within **ten (10) days** of receipt of this letter. You may initiate the transfer through your registrar.
3. Provide written confirmation that you have complied with the above and will not register or use any domain names incorporating "Nevada Assembly" or confusingly similar terms in the future.
4. Cease all representations that your activities are affiliated with, endorsed by, or representative of The Nevada Assembly.

Failure to comply fully within **ten (10) days** will leave the Assembly no choice but to pursue all available remedies, including:

- Filing a Uniform Domain-Name Dispute-Resolution Policy (UDRP) complaint with an ICANN-approved provider (e.g., WIPO or Forum) seeking transfer of the domain;
- Initiating federal court action under the ACPA, seeking transfer, cancellation, statutory damages up to \$100,000 per domain, actual damages, and attorneys' fees;
- Other lawful claims as appropriate.

This letter is without prejudice to the Assembly's rights and remedies, all of which are expressly reserved.

Govern yourself accordingly.

Nevada Assembly Militia Report on Domain Name Infringement

It gives me no pleasure to report, once again, on an issue that has been persistent for months on the Nevada Assembly, which is undermining the jurisdictional integrity of our Assembly and the continuing effort, by some, to undermine the jurisdiction and effectiveness of our collective work on Nevada.

It is exhausting having to cope with the continuous attacks on our great Nevada Assembly, but despite that, we are moving forward. Heads down, nose to the grindstone, we are progressing. We are standing our Militia and Jural Assemblies, we have regular and transparent meetings for The Nevada General Assembly, The Nevada Jural Assembly, The Nevada Union States Assembly, The Nevada Militia Assembly. We provide regular training, all documented and recorded with agendas and facts. We are in the process of revamping our State website in order to enhance our outreach and member services. We will be rolling out new email services and an auditable, convenient online voting system for our members. All of this is brought forward with the informed support of our General Assembly members, who are, after all, in charge.

It takes longer to do it this way. Without all the razzle-dazzle of rapid deployment, without the specific consent of Assembly member approval and debate. But it is stable, meaningful, and will last when done correctly.

I will now turn to the issue that presents itself today, which must be addressed by our membership.

Sometime in the late summer, early fall of last year, this group thought it wise to register a fraudulent internet domain name, thenevadaassemblygov.land. The use of a deceptively similar site name, plus the appeal to authority represented by the inclusion of 'gov' in the title, creates the appearance of jurisdictional authority, draws traffic away from the lawful Assembly's site, and deceives the public. This is a flagrant attempt to loot The Nevada Assembly of its recognized, common-law-protected identity. They created an unlawful, deceptive website and began distributing emails across our state and to our members, using their misleading domain to create authority they were never given. Case in point, we have evidence that Mr. Roper's email – coordinator@thenevadaassemblygov.land has been entered into multiple Official Land Recording Office (LRO) entries as the official Nevada State Coordinator contact for the LRO.

This is fraud. This will not stand.

On January 26, 2026, I sent a Cease-and-Desist Letter to William Rockie Roper and/or Associates via certified mail with return receipt requested (9589 0710 5270 2384 8166 01), to 1001 E. Sunset Rd - #96963, Las Vegas, Nevada 89199. This letter informed the recipients of their trespass and demanded that the use of the offending domain stop immediately and that the

domain thenevadaassemblygov.land be abandoned and turned over to The Nevada Assembly for safekeeping. You will find this document attached.

The letter was never received or signed for at this address, where Mr. Roper has previously received priority mail. It was returned unopened.

It has now become a matter for The Nevada Assembly to address openly and defend our jurisdictional authority against yet another unprovoked attack against us.

In the near future, we will deliberate this issue, as is our custom and obligation, with The Nevada General Assembly in order to determine future action on this matter. It is important to understand that we do not have to tolerate this kind of disruption on our Assembly. We have the right and the responsibility to stop it if the consensus is to do so.
