**RE: Formal Domain Abuse Complaint — Impersonation, Cybersquatting, and Deceptive Use****Infringing Domain: thenevadaassemblygov.land (Registered April 28, 2025)**

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Dear Abuse Team,

I am writing on behalf of The Nevada Assembly to submit a formal domain abuse complaint regarding a domain currently registered through PublicDomainRegistry.com that is being actively used to impersonate our organization, deceive our members, defraud the public, and interfere with our operations.

**1. The Parties**

**Complainant:** The Nevada Assembly, a civic membership organization operating at nevadaassembly.org since April 30, 2021. Our domain is registered with DreamHost (IANA ID: 431). Contact: Michael T. Wilson, coordinator@nevadaassembly.org.

**Infringing Domain:** thenevadaassemblygov.land — registered April 28, 2025 through PublicDomainRegistry.com (IANA ID: 303), with registrant identity concealed behind PrivacyProtect.org (contact@privacyprotect.org).

**Known Operator:** William Rockie Roper and associates, including Tamara Amaral. Address: 1001 E. Sunset Rd #96963, Las Vegas, Nevada 89199. Active domain email addresses: coordinator@thenevadaassemblygov.land, rockie.roper@thenevadaassemblygov.land, recordingsecretary@thenevadaassemblygov.land, outreach@thenevadaassemblygov.land, tamara.amaral@thenevadaassemblygov.land.

**2. Nature of the Abuse**

The domain `thenevadaassemblygov.land` incorporates the entirety of The Nevada Assembly's name and adds the term "gov" — falsely implying governmental authority — together with the ".land" extension, which mimics the land-and-soil jurisdiction language central to our organization's identity. The domain was registered approximately four years after our organization established `nevadaassembly.org`.

The domain has been used to:

- Operate a website claiming to be "The Nevada Union State (an unincorporated Union State)" — the "unincorporated government serving the national land and soil jurisdiction of Nevada" — directly impersonating the Complainant's organizational structure and purpose.
- Send mass email communications to the Complainant's members using addresses such as `coordinator@thenevadaassemblygov.land` and `recordingsecretary@thenevadaassemblygov.land`, presenting the operator as the official Nevada Coordinator and Recording Secretary of The Nevada Assembly.
- Fraudulently insert the email address `coordinator@thenevadaassemblygov.land` into multiple Official Land Recording Office (LRO) entries as the official Nevada State Coordinator contact. The operator is not the Nevada State Coordinator and was never authorized to represent himself as such. This constitutes fraud affecting real legal records.
- Use deceptive Land Recording Office stamps on official land jurisdiction paperwork that do not conform to stamps approved by the Nevada General Assembly membership, misleading members into making unauthorized filings.
- Direct visitors seeking to correct their political status to external resources unaffiliated with The Nevada Assembly, diverting newly interested members away from the legitimate organization.

### **3. Prior Attempts to Resolve the Dispute**

The Nevada Assembly has made extensive, documented attempts to resolve this matter:

- January 26, 2026 — A formal Cease and Desist Letter was sent via USPS Certified Mail (Tracking No. 9589 0710 5270 2384 8166 01) to William Rockie Roper, 1001 E. Sunset Rd #96963, Las Vegas, NV 89199. The letter was returned unopened. Roper has previously received priority mail at this address, confirming intentional refusal.
- February 28, 2026 — A licensed process server (Ebisee Solomon Regassa, Registration No. R-2024-03965, Nevada Legal Support Services, LLC) attempted to personally serve the Cease and Desist at a public meeting. Personal bodyguards physically blocked the server's approach and escorted the server from the premises. Roper was then covertly removed through a back exit to avoid service.

- March 5–6, 2026 — Two additional service attempts at Roper's residential address (20 Quiet Desert Lane, Henderson, NV 89074) were made. No answer was received on either occasion.

The operator has engaged in deliberate, escalating evasion of all attempts to resolve this matter, including the use of personal security to obstruct service of legal process.

#### **4. Violations of Registrar Policies and Applicable Law**

The conduct associated with this domain constitutes:

- Cybersquatting in violation of the Anticybersquatting Consumer Protection Act (ACPA), 15 U.S.C. § 1125(d) — the domain was registered with bad faith intent to profit from and disrupt The Nevada Assembly's established identity.
- Trademark infringement and unfair competition under the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1114 and 1125(a) — the domain misappropriates The Nevada Assembly's common law trademark.
- Fraud — fraudulent insertion of the infringing email address into Official Land Recording Office records as the authorized Nevada State Coordinator.
- Deceptive trade practices — the domain uses government-suggestive terminology ("gov") to falsely imply official authority.
- Violation of ICANN's Registrar Accreditation Agreement (RAA) prohibitions on use of a domain for deceptive or fraudulent purposes.

#### **5. Requested Action**

We respectfully request that PublicDomainRegistry.com take the following actions under your abuse policies:

- Immediately suspend the domain `thenevadaassemblygov.land` pending a full investigation of the documented abuse.
- Disclose the actual registrant identity behind the PrivacyProtect.org proxy (or require PrivacyProtect.org to do so) in accordance with ICANN's Temporary Specification for gTLD Registration Data and your RAA obligations.
- Cooperate fully with ICANN dispute resolution proceedings (UDRP) if initiated by the Complainant.
- Prevent further use of the domain for impersonation or fraudulent activity during the investigation period.
